KNOWING HOW TO LIVE — WHAT TO BE — WHAT TO DO

... Be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world (Phil 2:15).

We vividly remember what it was like during our years in Austria, living in a country where we had no citizenship. We could not own property, could not vote during elections, had no benefits for health, were not able to join the work force, and many other citizen benefits. It constantly reminded us that this place was not our home. We were called *Ausländer*, or in English, *foreigners*. It is interesting to find out that all the great heroes in Hebrews 11 confessed that they were *strangers and pilgrims on the earth*. Why? I love their answer: Heb 11:14, *For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country. 15 And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. 16 But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.*

Before continuing, we want to assure you that we will be voting on election day because it is our privilege and duty. Yet, regardless of the outcome, whether it was

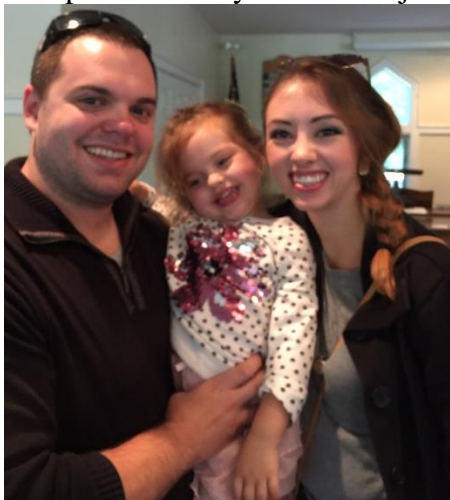
what we were hoping for or not, we know for sure these three things about God's will for His Pilgrims. First, we know how God wants us to live. We are to live by faith and by every word that proceeds from His mouth: Rom 1:17, ... *The just shall live by faith.* Matt 4:4, ... *Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.*

Second, we know what God wants us to be. That is the salt of the earth and the light of the world (Matt 5:13-14). Phil 2:15 ... *Be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world.* Third we know what God wants us to do. CREATING LEARNING CENTERS
